 Resolution No. 006-05

**“A RESOLUTION
 TREATING SENIOR NON-COMMISSIONED OFFICER’S MANDATORY
 TRAINING AT PNFI, FNFI AND JNFI-PPSC”**

WHEREAS, Section 66, RA 6975 created the PPSC, as the premier educational institution for the training, human resource development and continuing education of all personnel of the PNP, Fire and Jail Bureaus;

WHEREAS, the PPSC curriculum and standards development made a comprehensive and in depth review and evaluation of the existing public safety education and training courses on September to December 2004 to make it responsive to the needs and requirements of the public safety services;

WHEREAS, the PNP, Fire and Jail Bureaus at present have a great number of Non-Commissioned Officers who have not complied the mandatory training and as a consequence they were promoted with a status of temporary appointments. With that they have been experiencing and performing actual duties of leading Senior Non-Commissioned Officers. With that experience it would be impractical and inappropriate for them to take up their respective Junior Leadership Courses, which training does not correspond to their rank and position; and


WHEREAS, to prevent the increasing number of Non-Commissioned Officers who have no mandatory training and to avoid piling-up of untrained personnel and maximizing the training capabilities of Regional Training Schools in the interest of public service. Foregoing are policies formulated to be the basis for accrediting or exempting Senior Non-Commissioned Officers from training.

- a. The Tri-Bureau personnel who have the rank of SPO4, SJO4 and SFO4 shall be exempted from taking up their respective Junior Leadership Courses.
- b. SPO3, SJO3 and SFO3 with permanent appointments shall be exempted in taking up their respective Junior Leadership Courses.
- c. SPO3, SJO3 and SFO3 with temporary appointments may also be exempted in taking up their respective Junior Leadership Courses provided they have specialized schooling or training of at least two months duration.
- d. That this exemption may only be availed of by public safety officers who possess the abovementioned qualifications at the time of the effectivity of this Resolution.


NOW WHEREFORE, the Academic Board resolved, as it is hereby resolved that the above policy on “Senior PNCO who have no mandatory training shall be adopted upon approval.






